## Two Simple Steps to Apply for 2010 Green Certification

Connecticut hotels that achieve green certification will be highlighted on CTvisit.com, AAA.com, AAA Tour Books and various travel websites.

1. Complete the appropriate Green Workbook available at [www.ct.gov/dep/cwp/view.asp?a=2708&q=438218&depNav\\_GID=1763](http://www.ct.gov/dep/cwp/view.asp?a=2708&q=438218&depNav_GID=1763).
2. Submit your workbook to the CT DEP, Office of Pollution Prevention and the CT Commission on Culture and Tourism for review and approval. If your business scores 100 points, it qualifies for a certification from the State of Connecticut.
